CLASSIFICATION

ALL SHOOTERS must have a complete list of their target scores and averages up to date. If not up to date, shooter may be penalized at the discretion of the Classification Committee. Any shooter with less than a total of 500 16-yard targets for the current 2008-2009 year shall shoot no less than Class B. Any shooter who has shot less than 500 handicap targets for the current year shall shoot no less than 23 yards. Any shooter who has shot less than 300 doubles targets for the current year shall shoot no less than Class B. It shall be the shooter's responsibility to shoot the punched or stamped yardage on his card. (Whichever is the greater).

ALL TARGET requirements are based from September 1, 2007 and must be on your current card.

All Class winners and ties, resident and non-resident, must report to Handicap Committee for reclassification prior to the next day's event. It is the shooters responsibility to shoot the correct classification or yardage. Starting Wednesday, all ties and winners must move up a class.

I.R.S. regulations require a Social Security number before accumulated event winnings of over \$600 can be distributed. Classification Committee personnel will be able to directly input Social Security numbers at the time of classification. If you anticipate receiving option checks through the mail, it will be necessary to report your Social Security number at the time of classification.

The Classification Committee reserves the right to reclassify or disqualify any shooter at any time.

An error at the handicap table does not relieve a shooter of the responsibility of knowing the rules and shooting in the proper class and at the proper yardage.

SPECIAL CATEGORIES

IT IS THE SHOOTERS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL SPECIAL CATEGORIES (Lady, Junior, Sub-Junior, Veteran, Sr. Veteran) is clearly marked at time of classification and clearly marked on all entry sheets.

Lady, Junior, Sub-Junior, Veteran and Sr. Veteran shooters who declare such eligibility shall be so designated.

1. All female shooters shall be designated as Ladies, because of age they may also be designated as Juniors, Sub-Juniors, Veterans or Sr. Veterans.
2. A shooter who has not reached his or her 15th birthday will be designated as a Sub-Junior.
3. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his or her 18th birthday will be designated as a Junior.
4. A shooter who is 65 years or older will be designated as a Veteran.
5. A shooter who is 70 years or older will be designated as a Sr. Veteran.

There must be 5 entries in a special category before a trophy is awarded.

All ladies, veterans, senior veterans, juniors and sub-juniors will be allowed to shoot for targets and trophies without target requirements but no options will be allowed. If options are selected, penalty class or yardage will apply.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting of the Illinois State Association will be held Friday night, June 19, 2009 after shoot-offs. At this meeting, nominations for A.T.A. Delegate and Alternate Delegate will be accepted. The election of A.T.A. Delegate and Alternate Delegate will be held on Saturday, June 20, 2009 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. just outside the Hall of Fame alcove in the Brittany Shooting Park Clubhouse. To receive a ballot, you must be in possession of a 2009 ATA card and 2009 I.S.T.A. Membership.

STARTING TIME

PLEASE NOTE: Each day's program will start promptly at the time specified. YOU MUST BE READY TO SHOOT WHEN YOUR SQUAD IS POSTED OR CALLED. Any shooter missing his/her squad will be resquaded at the end of the program after paying a resquading fee of \$10.00. Check your squad number and please be ready.

A.T.A. RULES WILL GOVERN THIS TOURNAMENT

The management (directors) reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation or cause the withdrawal of any shooter who may, in their opinion, be interfering with the harmony of the shoot. The management also reserves the right to cancel, change, or step up the program in case of inclement weather.

A shooter may be disqualified for an event or for the whole tournament at any time by shoot management, who is under the obvious influence of alcohol or drugs before starting or during any event, sub-event, shoot-off or practice, or who consumes any alcoholic beverage or drugs during participation in any event, sub-event or between events or sub-events held on the same day including shoot-offs and practice.

TRAPS AND TARGETS

Automatic Pat Traps will be used on all fields. White Flyer Orange Dome targets will be thrown.

Targets will be set each morning, only authorized I.T.A. Personnel may reset targets.

Any unauthorized person observed resetting targets, may be disqualified from that event.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Anyone breaking 100 or 200 straight in Singles at the Illinois State Shoot, providing they have not won one previously, will be awarded a State Pin.

State Pins will also be awarded for Handicap and Doubles on 100 straight scores.

**ALL DOUBLES WILL BE SHOT 25 PAIR ON A TRAP IN ALL DOUBLES EVENTS.
50 TARGETS WILL BE SHOT ON EACH FIELD IN ALL SINGLES AND HANDICAP EVENTS.
PLEASE TAKE 50 SHELLS TO THE LINE.**

The shoot management reserves the right to shoot 10 per post should the need arise.

Officers and Directors of the Illinois State Trapshooters Association will make all decisions as to the interpretation of rules. The Directors decisions are final.

ALL I.S.T.A DIRECTORS ARE OFFICIAL LINE REFEREES.

Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times by all shooters, workers and anyone on the firing line. (No exceptions)

ENTRIES

Any shooter withdrawing from any event may not re-enter that event!

Options may be added prior to the start of the event. No entry fee refunded, including options and purses, unless shoot is canceled. Entries for events other than the current days shooting will be accepted after 1:00 p.m. The entry desk and cashier windows will close daily at 4:00 p.m. Payouts will be available the next day after 1:00 p.m.

Checks will be accepted for the amount of entry only. No refunds will be allowed. Credit cards will not be accepted.

WE WILL NOT CALL SQUAD NUMBERS ON THE PA SYSTEM

No shooter will be allowed to make up more than two (2) sub-events on the practice trap. Shooters will NOT be allowed to make up sub-events on program traps.

Note: If you are unable to join your squad before they have started their third sub-event, you must be resquaded and pay a \$10.00 resquading fee. If you miss two sub-events, you must report immediately to the I.S.T.A. classification office to make up the sub-events on the practice trap.

TROPHIES

No shooter may win more than one trophy in the same event. A contestant whose score qualifies for more than one trophy must notify shoot management which trophy he/she desires to accept or shoot off for. Failure of the contestant to notify shoot management within 15 minutes after the last events are posted defers to shoot management the right to make the decision for that shooter. Shoot management shall consider special category trophies superior to class trophies.

A shooter may not fall back to a special category trophy if unsuccessful in shooting off for a class or yardage trophy. This does not affect the right of a contestant to shoot off for an event championship or place trophies. A special category shooter may enter into a shoot off for event championship only and fall back to a special category trophy but must declare their intent prior to shoot offs. **A special category shooter that enters into a shoot off for runner up or place trophies must complete the shoot off, accept the result and cannot fall back to the special category.**

All trophies, ISTA and ATA will be awarded according to ATA rules and procedures.

Ladies, Juniors, Sub-Juniors, Veterans and Sr. Veterans trophies will be decided on all 200 targets of 200 target events.

All trophies must be picked up before the conclusion of the 2009 state shoot **NO TROPHIES WILL BE SHIPPED!**

The I.S.T.A. will not be responsible for any trophy left more than 30 days at the conclusion of the 2009 State Shoot.

Added money in all events will be awarded with trophy.

SHOOT-OFFS

All ties for A.T.A. and championship trophies will be shot off at the conclusion of the day's program, if possible. **Shooters must declare their intentions to shoot off for class, yardage or special category within 15 minutes after results are posted.** Officers of the State Association or their delegates will be in charge of all shoot-offs. Any shooter not answering the call, forfeit the shoot-off. Shoot-offs under lights if necessary. Other trophies may be carried over at the discretion of the Directors.

Options

All purses will be paid out percentage, not High Gun.

All results are final 1 hour after completion of event. All options are "ties divide"
Payouts available the next day after 1:00 p.m.

CAMPERS & VENDORS

Electric and water hook-ups are limited to 160. The rates are \$125.00 for the week or \$25.00 per night. Vending lots are \$125.00 a week. The \$125 per week runs from Monday, June 15th thru Sunday, June 21st, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.

SHELL PICK-UP

Shell pick-up will not be allowed during any part of this program!
